

## General Information

### 1. Registration

It is of great help to us if your child is referred to our specialist consultation by your paediatrician or family doctor. He/she knows your child well, and can already send us important information or the results of any preliminary clarifications. This cooperation makes an efficient and cost-saving special consultation possible for both you and us.

In principle, we can also accept applications directly from you. Patients using the family doctor model will always need a referral.

### 2. Invitation

You will receive a written invitation to the first consultation, indicating the planned examinations and providing any further information. These can also be found on this homepage, under Leaflets.

### 3. Documents

Please bring along your child's insurance card to the consultation, together with the health booklet with the vaccination certificate. The results of any preliminary clarifications would also be a great help. Medication and inhalation materials can also be brought along for checking.

### 4. Preparing your child

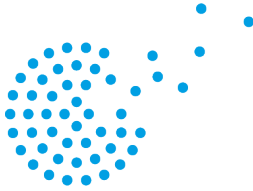
You will find photos, video links and leaflets about our examinations on our website.

Using these, you can tell your child in advance about the planned examinations and how they will be carried out. If you have questions or uncertainties, our experienced team will also be happy to assist you by phone.

### 5. Medication

Certain medications or foods could affect the test results. The following medicines must be discontinued before the appointment:

- a. Stop any anti-histamines (e.g. Feniallerg, Zyrtec, Xyzal or Aerius) 3 days beforehand



- b. Stop any cortisone nasal sprays (Avamys, Nasonex and Dymista) 7 days before
- c. Stop any Singulair/Lukair and Relvar 2 days before
- d. Stop any Symbicort, Vannair, Seretide, Oxis, Serevent, Flutiform 1 day before
- e. Inhale with Ventolin and Bricanyl for the last time on the evening before
- f. Do not stop any inhalation medications containing cortisone (Axotide, Alvesco, Pulmicort)
- g. Stop taking any oral medications containing cortisone (e.g. Betnesol and Spiricort) 3 days before the appointment

#### 6. How to get here

We recommend that you travel to us by public transport. The practice can be easily reached with the No. 3/31 bus (Oberdorf bus stop) or the No. 4 bus (Büelplatz bus stop).

Due to the heavy traffic in our region, please allow yourself sufficient time for the journey. Parking spaces are available in front of the practice, and in the Oberdorf Centre in Baar (Coop).

Please arrive 15 minutes before the appointment in order to complete your personal information.

#### 7. Cancellation of appointments

Please let us know in advance if you cannot keep your agreed appointment (at the latest 24 hours before). In case of later cancellations, we will no longer be able to reschedule, and will have to invoice you for the missed appointment.

#### 8. Billing

We normally invoice the health insurance company directly. In order to be able to do this, we need your approval on the registration form. Our medical practice assistants will be happy to assist if you have any questions about your invoice.
